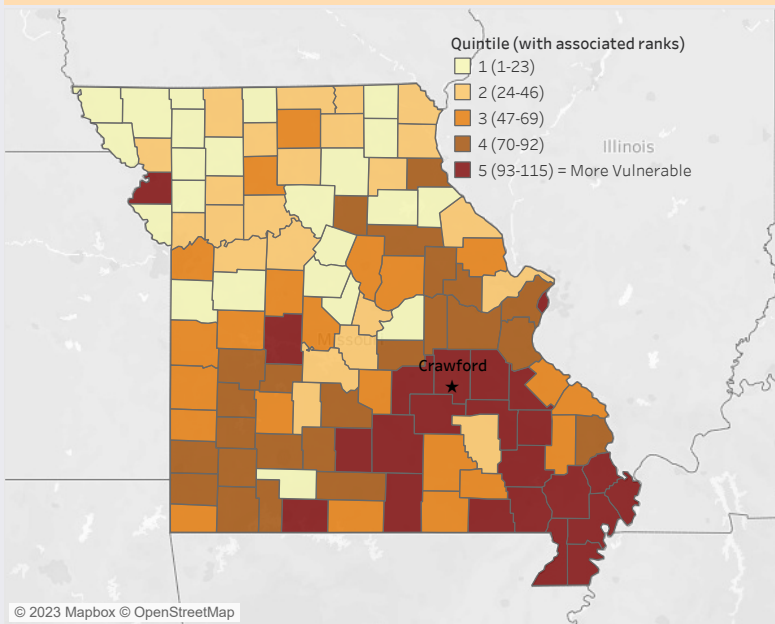
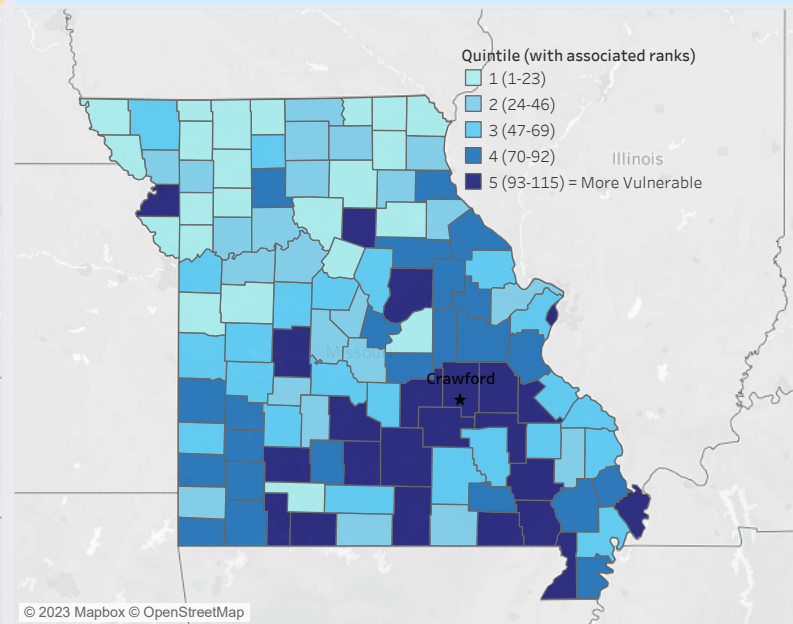


2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Crawford County

Opioid Overdose



Bloodborne Infection



Crawford County ranked in the 5th quintile (115th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment, and in the 5th quintile (115th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment as well. In the opioid overdose assessment, Crawford County ranked in the 5th quintile for 7 out of 11 indicators with the rate of opioid-related SUDT being its worst ranking at 114th. For the bloodborne infection assessment, it ranked in the 5th quintile for 7 out of 14 indicators with the rate of opioid misuse ER visits being its worst ranking at 111th. Social and economic factors were also included in these assessments, and the county's rate of unemployment and lack of a high school education had the lowest rankings.
