
2022 Vulnerability Assessment: Scott County



Scott County ranked in the 5th quintile (106th out of 115 counties) for the opioid overdose vulnerability assessment and in the 4th quintile (87th) for the bloodborne infection vulnerability assessment. In both the opioid overdose and the bloodborne infection assessments, Scott County's worst ranking was for the rate of drug-related arrests, both ranking 109th. While social and economic factors were included in both of these assessments, they did not have any indicator fall in the 5th quintile with the worst factor being the rate of poverty ranked at 89th.
