Suction catheters <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rigid tonsil tip</li> <li>• Flexible between 6-10 fr</li> <li>• Flexible between 12-16 fr</li> </ul>				
Oxygen delivery <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nasal cannula—adult and child</li> <li>• Non-rebreather masks—adult and child</li> </ul>				
Bag-valve-mask <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hand operated self-expanding bags—child (450-750 ml) and adult (&gt;1000 ml)</li> </ul> Masks for BVM (1 each) adult, child, infant, neonate				
Airways <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nasal airways—1 size between 16-24 fr and 1 size between 26-34</li> <li>• Oral airways—one in each size, 0-1, 2-3, 4-5</li> </ul>				
Pulse oximeter with pediatric and adult probes				
Bulb suction for infants (if not included in OB kit)				
AED that included pediatric capability				
Immobilization devices <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rigid cervical collars for children 2 years through adult (small, medium, large)</li> <li>• Lower extremity immobilization device—adult size, child size</li> <li>• Extremity immobilization devices to fit children and adults (small, medium, large)</li> </ul>
