I. Introductions

There were no new members on the meeting.

II. Trauma Regulation Update

Nicole Gamm reported that there is a waiver to do virtual Trauma reviews only for the initial trauma reviews for centers.

III. Trauma Statute update

No new updates.

IV. Data

Nicole Gamm, the TCD Manager for the state, presented some trauma statistics from 2020 out of the Missouri Trauma Patient Registry. The presentation is attached and has been sent out to the members.

Nicole discussed that one of the goals of TCD committee is to work more with other groups. She has been working with MODot and presented fatality data from them. As of August 23rd there have been 623 fatalities and 66% were unbuckled, which is slightly decreased from 2020. So far this year there has been 95 motorcycle crashes compared to 75 in 2020. Of those 51 were un-helmeted compared to 2 in 2020. There have been 58 pedestrians killed in 2021 and 71 in 2020.

Nicole reported that all 232 EMS agencies are reporting to the state. She shared data out of the state NEMSIS data. This data can be access through this link https://nemsis.org/.
