TSH BORDERLINE RISK**	<ul> <li>False Positive (TSH surge, other illness, prematurity)</li> <li>Possible hypothyroidism</li> <li>Maternal antibodies or medication</li> </ul>	Final results mailed to physician of record and submitter.	Repeat newborn screen, or do serum testing.
