

My brain hurts!

Do you have:

- Headaches
 - Dizziness
- Seizures
- Excessive fatigue (tiredness)
- Mood Swings (easily frustrated. anxious, angry, depressed, low self-esteem)
- Ringing in the ears
- Vision change
- Weakness or paralysis

Consequences of mild traumatic brain injury:

Do you have difficulty with:

- Balance and coordination
- Concentration
- Forgetting things (memory problems)
- Learning new things
- Sleep
- Speech and language (expressing thought or not understanding what is said)
- Physical disabilities
- Paying attention
- Problem solving
