Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Dead Bird Reporting As of December 31, 2011

The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) no longer tests dead birds for the presence of West Nile virus (WNV). Although birds die from many different infectious diseases or exposure to toxins, DHSS' Internet dead bird reporting form is being used to track reports of dead birds because they may be an early sign of WNV activity in an area.
